APPROVAL PROCESS and REGISTRATION:

1. Contact Linda Clark at the Child Development Division for an *Intent to Register* form. Ph: 1-800-649-2642, Ext. 1215 or e-mail: Linda.clark@ahs.state.vt.us .
2. If you are not already enrolled as a student at CCV or have never completed and passed the required CCV **Accuplacer Test**, contact Sarah or Nicole at 334-4451 **as soon as possible for directions about completing the Accuplacer test. You must complete the Accuplacer before** submitting the *Intent to Register* form .
3. **Complete the *Intent to Register* form and request a pre-course evaluation form** from Linda Clark. Return each of these to her for approval by **January 9, 2012**. **Approval of these does not automatically register you** in the class. Once the approved form and pre-evaluation is returned to you by Linda, you may register.
4. **To register:** log on to the CCV website at www.ccv.edu or call Sarah Corrow or Nicole Laliberte at **(802) 334-4451**. Once registered, you will be able to order your books through CCV.
5. **If you have been approved by the CDD, but decide not to take the class, notify Linda Clark immediately.**
