The Vermont State Colleges' prior learning assessment options help you get credit for any college-level learning you may have gained through work and training, military or community service, online or self-study. No matter which option is right for you, you can save money and graduate sooner.

## COURSE CHALLENGE AT CCV

As a Community College of Vermont (CCV) degree student you can challenge a CCV course by demonstrating your mastery of the course objectives of that course. You will be evaluated by a CCV faculty member who teaches the course. The process is completed within 60 days or less time. Awarded credits are CCV credits and fit right into your degree program.

### COURSE CHALLENGE IS A GREAT VALUE

You pay a one-time course challenge fee which is much less than the cost of a course. There is no additional cost for the credits received through course challenge. You can challenge up to three CCV courses.

### COURSE CHALLENGE IS A GOOD OPTION FOR YOU IF YOU....

- Are a CCV degree student with a degree plan
- Learned on your own through in-service workshops, online courses, trainings, or self-study
- Have gained learning that is equivalent to a course offered at CCV
- Are confident you have the knowledge necessary to cover the course material
- Have discussed this option and got approval from your CCV advisor
